

Overview

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Barbados (ICAB) was created by an Act of Parliament on November 1, 1974. ICAB is the sole regulatory body for the accounting profession in Barbados and its vision is "To be recognised globally as the trusted and relevant resource in Barbados serving the accounting profession and the public interest."

Since 2009, ICAB has hosted Accountants' Week in the first full week in November as a means of profiling and highlighting the relevance of the accounting profession and giving back to the public. This year, Accountants' Week, which will incorporate International Accountants Day which falls on November 10, 2021, will be celebrated from November 7 – 13, 2021 under the theme Purpose Passion Possibilities and will be made up of the following events:



STUDENTS' CONFERENCE

The 5th Annual Students' Conference was organised by ICAB's Education & Student Services Committee with the aim of providing accounting students with an opportunity to hone their technical skills as well as enhance their personal growth and development. The conference was held under the theme "The Accounting Profession Post COVID-19" and the feature address was given by the Senator Hon.

Kay McConney, Minister of Innovation, Science and Smart Technology. The conference was hosted virtually over two days and comprised of four plenary sessions which focussed on Digital Transformation and the Accounting Profession and Workplace Transformation. The event was very well received with 80% of attendees rating it Excellent or Very Good.

ACCOUNTANTS' GIVE-BACK DAY

For the 3rd year in a row, ICAB members were encouraged to spread the word about the profession and ICAB by engaging in their own projects such as giving talks or donating money, books or supplies, and then to share what they had done via emails or posts on social media.




PUBLIC LECTURE
